Holy Spirit, Light Divine: Shine upon this heart of mine; Chase the shades of night away; turn the darkness into day; Let me see my Savior's face; let me all His beauties trace; Show those glorious truths to me which are only known to Thee. Amen.

_Mark 11:1–10 <u>"Go into the village in front of you, and immediately as you enter it you will find a colt tied, on which no one has ever sat. Untie it and bring it. If anyone says to you, 'Why are you doing this?' say, 'The Lord has need of it and will send it back here immediately.'"</u>

In the Name of Jesus.

The Small Catechism of Doctor Martin Luther bids us to celebrate the opening of each Day—ANY moment of MOMENT!—with the words given by our Lord. Saint Mark has it, 'He who believes and is baptized shall be saved!' Thus, BATHING our 'believing'—whatever THAT is!—within HIS washing: no DOUBT about what THAT is!

As each Lord's Day unfolds in the liturgy of the Christian Church. Saint Matthew has it: 'In the Name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.' Beee-cause....my dear ones:

Jesus Christ HAS...ALREADY: DONE-AND-DONE!...

Your God-in-Man-for-certain has done away with EVERY gap there could be between Real God and each man. That's the gladness that comes with the repetition of 'immediately' on the Day Christ rode on in Heaven's majesty: lowly, on a donkey, with nothing now between Him...and oppression and humility and the cross AND YOU! And me; and every creature! "Preach this Good News to ever creature!"

Slow down with me, my friends. 'Preach MY Gospel to EVERY creature!' AS...IF!

As IF it is THAT SIMPLE! 'Well, we'll just go up to every creature and speak of God and man in happy union now: God serving man, as a Man, come not to BE served, but to serve, and to give His life as a ransom for many.'

Our WORDS and DEEDS and LOOKS and RE...ACTIONS—in harmony with the washing with which WE have been washed—ALL what's US now will just be OOZING with Good Cheer for every last of the six billion plus of us dear creatures—and our little dogs, too!

Christians! Why NOT?! There is nothing on HIS SIDE that stands in the way! Because of His 'immediacy.'

Oh, my dearly beloved: this is your poor pastor's strength, if he has one; and his weakness. I read that word 'immediately' and see it twice in one reading, and I'm hooked. I beg you to bear with me, fish on the line.

Half the occurrences of this word in the New Testament are in the Gospel According to Saint Mark. There's a DOZEN of 'em in the first chapter alone! 'Immediately!' Two things.

One: this 'immediately' has NOTHING to do with 'suddenness,' and 'fright' or 'surprise.' Actually, somewhat the opposite! Not surprise, but—promised and waited for and expected! Not 'sudden,' but, 'at last!' Not 'fright,' but Jesus.

And another thing: sometimes, something is lost when we 'update' our Bible translations. How to keep the baby and throw out the old water?

'Make STRAIGHT the way of the Lord!' is the cry from Isaiah through the Baptizer—and then, at last, OF COURSE!, the Son of God!

And the translation King James of England gets the credit for reveals to us dear, dear men who knew what's what in the original and translated OUR 'immediately' as 'STRAIGHTWAY!'

Now. Bask; enjoy; hear; believe it all! The Spirit of Jesus tells us NOTHING is beyond HIM when it comes to making all our sad things come untrue!

Before the cock crow twice, thou shalt deny me thrice. And when he thought thereon, he wept.

15 And astraightway in the morning the chief priests held a consultation with the elders and scribes and the whole bcouncil, and bound Jesus, and ccarried *him* away, and delivered *him* to Pilate.³

What do we see? Most important: a few fellas who refused to listen to the Small Catechism of Doctor Martin Luther! The FIRST thing you do when you rise is NOT get together with your religious buddies and tattle to the most IRRELIGIOUS about a loose cannon in town telling all men that heaven is now come to earth and everything is set straight!

Second: what to say about Peter.

Well, being a Lutheran really helps! Just keep reading until you run across his name again!

Y'all see why I urge you to use that dirty paper they thrown on your lawn every day mostly just to line the bird cage? Why I plead with you to free YOURSELF from those little people stuck in the boxes in our homes: their heads, blabbing and yakking and raising fear and doubt? If we ALL turn them off, the Lord will free them from those boxes!

WHERE we have been absent, denying, less than OOZING with pardon for every creature: HE gets straight to every creature, even where we hesitate. Confessing the gaps you invent, and your pastor filling in those gaps with pardon from heaven on earth: why else was I created?

WHEN we make the Gospel and Holy Baptism last and least in our day: the ONLY thing that heaven observes!—

Yet He has his time—often!—to give us His Bread to eat with His Body, His Wine to drink with His Blood.

'Tell His disciples about THEIR rising! His too! Even Peter.'

Straightway, nothing in between, immediately God with us men, every creature, even me, even you in the Name of Jesus.
